#### Enroll online

If you prefer to sign up online

1. Log on to [www.amritahospital.org](http://www.amritahospital.org)
2. Scroll down and on the right side of the page
3. Click on Hospital **Patient Portal**.
4. On the Welcome page click on **Sign Up**.

You will need a valid email address. You will get a verification email from the portal. Follow the instructions in the email to activate your user account and sign in. Your email address will be the User Name for the Patient Portal. Keep your User name and Password confidential. Once you sign in you will see "your name" at the top of the page.

If you are an existing patient at the Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, make sure your Patient Registration Card (MRD) provided by the hospital is ready with you. You will also need a mobile phone. Click on Link Your Medical Record (MRD).

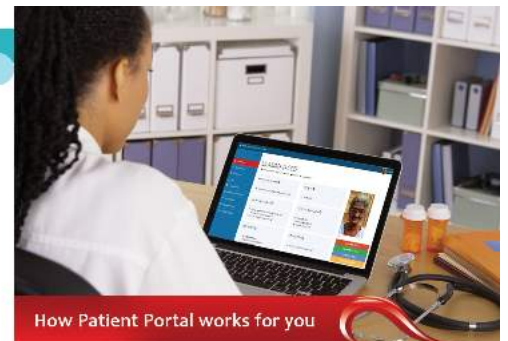
**Step1** – Authenticate Yourself. Enter your Mobile Number and click here to Generate OTP. Portal sends an OTP to this mobile number. Enter the OTP and click on Go to Linking Credentials.

**Step2** - Verify Patient Credentials. This is where you enter your MRD Number, Full Name, Date of Birth as you listed on your Patient Registration Form at AIMS. You may refer your Patient Registration Card (MRD). You will also need to enter any one of the information in the right hand side correctly – Last Visited Specialty, or Registration Date, or Registered email or Registered mobile number. The MRD linking will be confirmed by an email from the portal and you need to activate the link from the email. This will take you back to the Sign In page of the Portal. Once you sign in you will get Patient Portal Dashboard.

#### Enrollment through Amrita HIS

If you are new patient, make sure to provide your email address and mobile number in the Patient Registration Form. When the staff at the Registration Counter creates an MRD Number for you in the Hospital Information System, you will be automatically signed up with the Patient Portal. Your user credentials will be sent to you via SMS.

If you are an existing patient, portal sign up happens when you visit any of the OPDs or book appointment, provided your registration information in the hospital records contain a valid mobile number and email address.



How Patient Portal works for you

#### FREE AND SECURE ONLINE ACCESS

Patient Portal provides FREE and SECURE online access to your personal health information through an encrypted password-protected login process. All Portal URLs are secured and encrypted to ensure the protection of your personal health information. But safekeeping and remembering your login username and password are your responsibility. Should you forget the password, you have the option to create a new one.

#### AT YOUR CONVINIENCE

Amrita Patient portal is an online service which allows patients to access portions of your medical records online. Time consuming tasks like retrieving lab results and booking appointments are now possible in a few mouse clicks. (Put these 2 sentences and the caption as a Sidebar)
